### How to get started:

- If you have not yet identified a funding opportunity, and wish to explore project ideas and/or potential funding sources please contact us at [generator@sheridancollege.ca](mailto:generator@sheridancollege.ca)
- Complete the Expression of Interest (EOI) form on Generator's Sheridan Central page.
- Seek approval from your Associate Dean or Supervisor.
- Submit the completed EOI to the GSO.
- Work with the GSO to develop your grant application and submit it to the funding agency.
- Should your application get approved, the GSO will help manage the administration of the grant while you focus on your research!
